

## ***INFORMATION AND DIRECTIONS TO “YAPPY HOUR”***

This years ‘yappy hour’ and dinner will take place **Saturday, May 19, 2018** , 5:30 -7:30 pm at a new location – the Rancho Bernardo Community Park by the Ed Brown Center (18448 West Bernardo Drive, San Diego, CA 92127).

Dinner is \$20 a person and will be:

- pulled pork
- BBQ chicken
- coleslaw
- baked beans
- 1 drink (bottled water, soda, beer, wine)
- Due to various food allergies, humans are encouraged to bring their own food for their poodles.

\*\*\*People may purchase more drinks for a slight fee \*\*\*

Humans and poodles will enjoy an outdoor area to relax and romp in all to ourselves and can stay until 9:30 pm.

### **Directions:**

#### **From the South:**

- take I-15 freeway north
- exit Pomerado Rd/West Bernardo Drive
- turn left at the end of the exit so that you are going over the freeway
- turn right at your first traffic light, which will be the entrance to the Rancho Bernardo Community Park
- once in the park, go to the second building on your left. It is the Ed Brown Center and has a blue awning.

There is a sidewalk on the right side of the building that will lead you to the back of the building where the event is taking place. We will have a few ‘yard sale’ size signs indicating “Poodles On Parade”.

#### **From the North:**

- take I-15 freeway south
- exit West Bernardo Drive
- turn left at the end of the exit
- turn right at your first traffic light, which will be the entrance to the Rancho Bernardo Community Park
- once in the park, go to the second building on your left. It is the Ed Brown Center and has a blue awning.

There is a sidewalk on the right side of the building that will lead you to the back of the building where the event is taking place. We will have a few 'yard sale' size signs indicating "Poodles On Parade".
