

Sunday, Fun-day: Beach Outing with the Poodles

We will all be heading to Fiesta Island beach on Sunday, 10 am through 12 pm for the last fun romp of the weekend.

Since this is at the beach, it is suggested that you bring the following items for you and your poodle (s) - please be responsible and bring these items yourself and do not rely on others to supply the items for your dogs:

- bowl and water for your dog as there is no drinking water available and you shouldn't rely on others
- towel (very important)
- a beach chair and or blanket/towel to sit on
- sunscreen
- bags to pick up after your dog
- there are no bathrooms at the beach, just porta-potties.
- you do not have to take your dog off leash if you feel you may not have total control over him/her. You can still attend and keep your dog on a leash. We have had a few (including me) who have done this in the past.

DIRECTIONS TO FIESTA ISLAND:

- Take I-5 to Sea World Drive
- Make a right on East Mission Bay Drive (traffic light)
- Make an immediate left on Fiesta Island Drive
- Once you enter Fiesta Island, you will travel exactly 2 miles before reaching our location.
- you will see the first fork in the road immediately upon entering Fiesta Island. Stay to your right.
- when you get to the second fork in the road, stay to your right (always stay to your right)
- drive around the bend and continue until you see a large dirt parking area (2 miles).
- You will see a maroon mini van with a standard poodle social club banner. It will be parked close to the street.
- Fiesta Island only has one street and it is a one-way street. If you get to the official dog park area, you have gone about a 1/2 mile too far. You will have to circle around the island again. Just keep an eye out for poodles having fun!
